The Interdisciplinary work group for ethics of medicine in Poland and Germany meets this year already for the third time after the past conferences in Halle/Saale (fall 2012) and Frankfurt/Oder (summer 2013). From 21 July through 23 July 2014, the work group gathers in Łódź at the Institute of Administration and Law at Łódź University to discuss ethical and legal aspect of prenatal medicine in interdisciplinary perspectives. A primary focus will be on questions regarding the technical feasible and the ethically reasonable concerning prenatal medicine alongside an inquiry into the ethical legitimisation of medical decisions as well as the reflection of the legal conditions of prenatal medicine.

As a second focus, the conference will discuss reproductive medicine. With regard to the concept of responsible parenthood we will examine changes in family structure besides the promises of as well as the expectations that are directed at reproductive medicine. In discussing these two foci, practitioners and theorists from both Poland and Germany will initialize a transnational dialog.
