Dr Jutta Gampe is Head of the Laboratory of Statistical Demography at the Max Planck Institute for Demographic Research, Germany. She is also Deputy Head for Research of the Max Planck International Research Network on Aging (MaxNetAging).

She studied Technical Mathematics at TU Vienna and received her PhD in Statistics from TU Berlin. She was Visiting Professor at the Institute of Statistics at the LMU Munich and lectures regularly in the European Doctoral School for Demography. From 2009 to 2013 she was Chair of the Statistical Modelling Society.

Her research focus is on methodology development in demography with an emphasis on health and mortality. Current projects include mortality for supercentenarians, assessing mortality deceleration, an international database on longevity, modelling mortality in the presence of response-linked censoring and estimation in multi-state models. She has published extensively in the fields of mortality and gerontology and is an Associate Editor for the journal *Demographic Research*.
