Colorectal Cancer Biology: Clinicopathologic characteristics, Mismatch Repair (MMR) status and prognostic factors of colorectal carcinoma in Sub-Saharan Africa

The aim of my research is to determine the prevalence of mismatch repair status (MLH1, PMS2, MSH2, and MSH6) in colorectal carcinoma in different regions of SSA and assess the association of demographic and histomorphologic characteristics with mismatch repair status. Furthermore, histological data including histopathological grading, tumor infiltrating lymphocytes, differentiation, and tumor budding, will be evaluated, along with prognostic factors pertaining to protein, RNA, and DNA levels. The significance of MMR status lies in its potential as a biomarker for predicting treatment response and prognosis.
