



Assoc prof. Katarína Šebeková, MD, DrSc. graduated from Comenius University Medical Faculty (CU MF) in Bratislava in 1981, *summa cum laude*. She obtained board certificates in clinical biochemistry, the diploma in Certified methods in clinical trials of drugs, habilitated from internal medicine, and was awarded a title of Doctor of Medical Sciences (DSc.) at Slovak Academy of Sciences (SAS). During 2006-2011 she acted as a Vice-rector for Research Affairs at Slovak Medical University. She completed the courses of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) on intellectual property and patent drafting. As visiting scientists she stayed at the Laboratory for Nephrology at University of Würzburg, Germany (DAAD fellowship); and at the Department of Nephrology of Children Hospital of East Ontario, Ottawa, Canada (Partnership for Tomorrow Program of Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada). Currently she is employed as a leading scientist at Institute of Molecular Biomedicine at CU MF in Bratislava.

Doc. MUDr. Katarína Šebeková, DrSc. focuses mainly on uremic toxicity, advanced glycation end products, metabolic syndrome, and obesity. Her H-index is 26, she published >150 papers in peer-reviewed journals, reaching >1 800 citations. She has been engaged in several domestic and international projects (including COST actions and three EU FP programs). She is a member of the Slovak Medical Society, the European Association for the Study of Diabetes, the Scientific Board of the SAS for Medical Science, and the editorial board of *Kidney and Blood Pressure Research*.
